SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 525. BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR,

A PROCLAMATION.

J. FLETCHER-COOKE,

Acting Governor.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Meniko and Mitsero, in the District of Nicosia.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Law, and of every other power and authority enabling me in Cap. 256 that behalf, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby order and proclaim that from 17 of 1951 and after the 1st day of November, 1951, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Meniko, in the District of Nicosia, shall form part of the lands of the village of Mitsero, in the District of Nicosia, and that the boundaries of the said villages of Meniko and Mitsero shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Meniko village to Mitsero village.

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 509 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.30, locality "Kamila", which corner is on a track leading from the village of Akaki to Akhera Monastery and to the village of Mitsero and proceeds eastwards, southwestwards, north-westwards and northwards along the boundaries of and including the said plot, plots Nos. 1 and 5 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.38 and plot No. 52 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.37, locality "Kharti", to the most northern point of plot No. 1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXIX.38, which point is on the said track; thence north-westwards along the said track to the point of commencement, all which boundary of the said area is shown edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1516.
