THE WELLS LAW.

CAP. 312 AND LAW 19 OF 1951.

ORDER BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR

UNDER SECTION 3A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3A of the Wells Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby define for the purposes of the said section the areas set out in the Schedule hereto as areas in which no permit for the sinking or construction of a well shall be issued by the Commissioner and no variation or modification of any condition or restriction imposed on any such permit shall be effected, save with the concurrence of the Water Engineer, in accordance with the provisions of the said section.

2. Notice under section 3A (2) of the Wells Law in respect of this Order was published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 29th August, 1951.

SCHEDULE.

Defined Areas.

1. In Kokkini Trimithia village in the District of Nicosia, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the bridge over which the Cyprus Government Railway line crosses the Merika river and proceeds due north in a straight line for a distance of 3,670 yards approximately to a point on the village road leading from the village of Philia to the village of Mammari, locality "Policin"; thence eastwards and south-eastwards along the said road to its junction with another road leading from the village of Mammari to the village of Yerolakkos, locality "Kolymbos"; thence eastwards in a straight line to the junction of a footpath with the asphalt road leading from the village of Yerolakkos to Nicosia Airport, locality "Kamarospilios"; thence southwards along the said asphalt road to its junction with the Nicosia-Troodos main road, locality "Ovgos"; thence southwards in a straight line to a junction of tracks, which junction is on a road leading from the village of Pano Dheftera to the village of Ayii Trimithias, locality "Laxia tou Markou"; thence westwards along one of the tracks to the point where it reaches to the Mavromargo river; thence north-westwards along the right bank of the said river, Koutis Potamos and Merika river to the point of commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1507 signed by the Commissioner of Nicosia bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Nicosia.

2. In Nicosia town in the District of Nicosia, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at milepost No. 2 on the Troodos-Nicosia main road and proceeds eastwards along the said main road to its junction with the Nicosia bye-pass; thence north-westwards along the said bye-pass to its junction with the Myrtou-Nicosia main road; thence eastwards along the said main road to the eastern edge of the built-up area of Ayios Dhometios where it is joined by a road which is the continuation of Argyrokastron Street; thence north-eastwards along the said street and Argyrokastron Street to its junction with Saint Paul (Ayios Pavlos) Street; thence south-eastwards along the last-mentioned street to its junction with Tennyson Street; thence south-eastwards along the last-mentioned street to the Pedieos bridge; thence eastwards (crossing the said bridge) along Cinyras Road to Paphos Gate; thence southwards along King Farouk Avenue to its junction with Homer Road; thence south-eastwards along the last-mentioned road to its junction with Leonidas Street; thence south-eastwards along the last-mentioned street to its junction with Pluto Street; thence south-eastwards along the last-mentioned street to its junction with Dighenes Akritas Road, which junction is opposite the Larnaca Road Police Station; thence south-eastwards and eastwards along the Nicosia-Larnaca main road to its junction with another asphalt road leading to Athalassa Farm; thence southwards along the last-mentioned asphalt road to the Athalassa Farm buildings; thence south-eastwards along the Yeri village road to the forest delimitation line of the Athalassa Main State Forest; thence westwards and north-westwards along the said delimitation line up to the point where it reaches to Nicosia-Limassol main road; thence southwards along the said main road to milepost No. 3 on the said main road; thence westwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of Arkhangelos Monastery; thence north-westwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of Makedhohitissa Monastery; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the point of

commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1506 signed by the Commissioner of Nicosia bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Nicosia.

3. In Famagusta town in the District of Famagusta, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the junction with the Karpas-Famagusta main road of another road coming from the village of Engomi, locality "Pallouri" and proceeds due east in a straight line to the seashore; thence south-eastwards along the seashore (but including all the islands off the seashore) up to a point 4,340 yards approximately due east of Dherinia village; thence westwards in a straight line to a road junction near the said village which junction is at the north-western corner of the built-up area of the village and is on the road leading from the said village to the Larnaca-Famagusta main road; thence north-westwards along the said road to its junction with the Famagusta-Larnaca main road, locality "Skasmata"; thence northwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of Ayios Yeoryios Church, locality "Bende"; thence due east in a straight line to the Famagusta-Karpas main road; thence north-westwards along the said main road to the point of commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1508 signed by the Commissioner of Famagusta bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Famagusta.

4. In Phrenaros village in the District of Famagusta, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the north-eastern corner of Ayios Andreas Church, locality "Kamini Andriou" and proceeds due north in a straight line up to a point 3,833 yards approximately from the said point, locality "Mosphili Noshou"; thence eastwards in a straight line to the junction of a footpath with a road leading from the village of Phrenaros to the Larnaca-Famagusta main road; thence southwards in a straight line to a road junction 2,333 yards approximately east of Liopetri village, locality "Kamini tis Politikis"; thence westwards in a straight line to the point of commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1510 signed by the Commissioner of Famagusta bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Famagusta.

5. In Makrasyka-Kalopsidha villages in the District of Famagusta, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at milepost No. 24 on the direct Nicosia-Famagusta main road and proceeds south-eastwards along the said main road through the village of Kalopsidha to its junction with a track leading from the village of Kalopsidha to Akhyritou Reservoir, locality "Alonia"; thence north-eastwards along the said track to the western bank of the said reservoir, locality "Conia"; thence southwards along the said bank of the reservoir to the point at which it approaches the Nicosia-Famagusta main road most nearly (near milepost 29) locality "Pamboula tou Sourtoumina"; thence due south to the said main road; thence north-westwards along the said main road to its junction with Famagusta-Larnaca main road; thence south-westwards along the last-mentioned main road to milepost No. 14, near the village of Athna; thence westwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of Arkhangelos Church, locality "Cata Petra"; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the south-eastern corner of Ayios Yeoryios Church, locality "Laxies"; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the point of commencement, all which

boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1509 signed by the Commissioner of Famagusta bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Famagusta.

6. In Pergamos village in the District of Larnaca, the area within the following boundary, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at milepost No. 11 on the main road from the village of Lefkoniko to Larnaca Town and proceeds eastwards in a straight line to the south-western corner of Arkangelos Church, locality "Cata Petra"; thence southwards in a straight line to the road junction at the locality "Ayios Vassilios"; thence along the road leading from the village of Xylotymbou to the Larnaca-Lefkoniko main road as far as its junction with the said main road; thence due west in a straight line to a point 2,333 yards approximately from the said junction, locality "Plati"; thence due north in a straight line up to a point 4,333 yards approximately from the said point, locality "Lakkospilio"; thence westwards in a straight line to the point of commencement, all which boundary is more particularly delineated on a plan marked Serial No. 1511 signed by the Commissioner of Larnaca bearing date 27th July, 1951, and deposited at the office of the Commissioner of Larnaca.

No. 557. THE DISEASES OF PLANTS PREVENTION LAW. CAP. 80.

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Diseases of Plants Prevention Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a place infected with the disease *Lepidosaphes beekii* (known as Mussel scale).

2. The following declarations of infected areas are hereby revoked:—

- (a) Declaration dated 14th August, 1935, published under Notification No. 924 in the *Gazette* of the 16th August, 1935;
- (b) Declaration dated 18th March, 1941, published under Notification No. 56 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th March, 1941;
- (c) Declaration dated 18th March, 1941, published under Notification No. 57 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th March, 1941.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of the Akrotiri peninsula and neighbourhood including the town of Limassol, the villages of Episkopi, Kandou, Erimi, Kolossi, Ypsonas, Trakhoni, Akrotiri, Asomatos, Pano and Kato Polemidhia, Ayia Phyla, Mesayitonia, Ayios Athanasios, Yermasoyia, Moutayiaka, Zakaki and Cherkez Chiftlik.

The landward boundary of the said area is shown edged red on a Government Survey map signed by the Director of Agriculture and deposited in the office of the Assistant Agricultural Superintendent, Limassol.
