No. 562. THE VILLAGE AUTHORITIES LAW.
CAP. 256 AND LAW 17 OF 1951.

PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 17.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Myrmikoph, in the District of Paphos, should be abolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Law, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby proclaim that the village of Myrmikoph in the District of Paphos be, for all administrative purposes, abolished as from the 1st day of December, 1951, and that the whole of the present area of the said village be transferred to Pelathousa village in the District of Paphos and form one common area of the said village of Pelathousa as from the said date.

No. 563. THE GOVERNMENT WATERWORKS LAW.
CAP. 305 AND LAW 24 OF 1949.

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 34 (2) (a).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 34 (2) (a) of the Government Waterworks Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Irrigation Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931 and 1937 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931 to 1951.

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
