THE MINIMUM WAGE LAW.

Cap. 215 In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Minimum Wage Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wage (Nahieh of Paphos) Order, 1951.

2. The minimum rates of wages to be paid to female packers, graders and sorters of agricultural produce in the Nahieh of Paphos shall be as follows :—

- (a) for female workers under 18 years, the rate shall be $3/4\frac{1}{2}$ for an eight-hour day with an overtime rate of 5p. for every extra hour;
- (b) for female workers of 18 years and over, the rate shall be 4/- for an eight-hour day with an overtime rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ p. for every extra hour.

No. 588. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 142.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2518.

MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Marathovouno (Famagusta District) to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 10 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. The Village Health Commission of Marathovouno (Famagusta District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of two hundred pounds (£200) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the Lender in four equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) the Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate;
- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the purpose of improving the streets within the village.
