REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Bombardment Range Areas (Amendment) Regulations, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Bombardment Range Areas Regulations, 1949 and 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Bombardment Range Areas Regulations, 1949 to 1952.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after regulation 15, of the following regulations :—

"THE GOSHI BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

16. In this part of these regulations, the "Goshi Bombardment Range Area" means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice to be published in the *Gazette* or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.

17. The Goshi Bombardment Range Area shall only be used by day and the signals to be hoisted in respect thereof shall be as follows :—

- (i) By a red flag hoisted on the highest point of the high ground at the NORTHERN extremity of the area.
- (ii) By red flags hoisted at the NORTH-EASTERN, NORTH-WESTERN, SOUTH-WESTERN AND SOUTH-EASTERN extremities of the area.
- (iii) By flags hoisted at the centre of the EASTERN and WESTERN boundaries of the area.

THE POLEMIDHIA BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

18. In this part of these regulations, the "Polemidthia Bombardment Range Area" means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice to be published in the *Gazette* or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.

19. The danger signals to be hoisted in respect of the Polemidhia Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows :—

(a) *By Day.*

- (i) By a red flag hoisted on the road WEST of the stop butts.
- (ii) By a red flag hoisted at the highest point of the hill directly NORTH of the stop butts.
- (iii) By a red flag hoisted on the highest point of the hill on the EAST of the range.

(b) *By Night.*

By red lamps hoisted on flag poles situated as in (a) (i), (ii) and (iii) above.

THE KARAOLOS BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

20. In this part of these regulations, the "Karaolos Bombardment Range Area" means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice to be published in the *Gazette* or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.

21. The danger signals to be hoisted in respect of the Karaolos Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows:—

(a) *By Day.*

- (i) By a red flag hoisted on the stop butts.
- (ii) By a red flag hoisted 200 yards EAST of the stop butts.
- (iii) By a red flag hoisted 300 yards SOUTH-WEST of the stop butts.
- (iv) A red flag hoisted at a point 100 yards to the SOUTH-WEST of the 600 yards firing point.
- (v) A red flag hoisted at a point 100 yards to the SOUTH-EAST of the 600 yards firing point.

(b) *By Night.*

By red lamps hoisted on flag poles situated as in (a) (i), (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) above.

THE ATHALASSA BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

22. In this part of these regulations, the "Athalassa Bombardment Range Area" means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice to be published in the *Gazette*, or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.

23. The signals to be hoisted or displayed in respect of the Athalassa Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows:—

(a) *By Day.*

- (i) By a red flag hoisted on the high ground to the SOUTH-EAST of the range.
- (ii) By a red flag hoisted at the road junction NORTH of the range.
- (iii) By a red flag hoisted on the road from Athalassa to 400 yards SOUTH of the range.
- (iv) By a red flag hoisted on the road 100 yards NORTH-WEST from the 600 yards firing point.

(b) *By Night.*

By a red light displayed on flag poles at each of the places mentioned at (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of (a) above."

THE GOSHI BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

The boundary is a rectangle 4,374 yards by 3,281 yards or thereabouts, the longer side lying in a grid north and south direction and the south-western corner of the said rectangle is a point 40 yards or thereabouts north-east
