- 21. The danger signals to be hoisted in respect of the Karaolos Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows:—
 - (a) By Day.

(i) By a red flag hoisted on the stop butts.

- (ii) By a red flag hoisted 200 yards EAST of the stop butts.(iii) By a red flag hoisted 300 yards SOUTH-WEST of the stop butts.
- (iv) A red flag hoisted at a point 100 yards to the SOUTH-WEST of the 600 yards firing point.
- (v) A red flag boisted at a point 100 yards to the SOUTH-EAST of the 600 yards firing point.
- (b) By Night.

By red lamps hoisted on flag poles situated as in (a) (i), (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) above.

THE ATHALASSA BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREA.

- 22. In this part of these regulations, the "Athalassa Bombardment Range Area" means the area declared as such under section 2 of the Law by notice to be published in the *Gazette*, or by any other notice amending or substituted for the same.
- 23. The signals to be hoisted or displayed in respect of the Athalassa Bombardment Range Area shall be as follows:—
 - (a) By Day.
 - By a red flag hoisted on the high ground to the SOUTH-EAST of the range.
 - (ii) By a red flag hoisted at the road junction NORTH of the range.
 - (iii) By a red flag hoisted on the road from Athalassa to 400 yards SOUTH of the range.
 - (iv) By a red flag hoisted on the road 100 yards NORTH-WEST from the 600 yards firing point.
 - (b) By Night.

By a red light displayed on flag poles at each of the places mentioned at (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) of (a) above."

of another point on the Nicosia-Larnaca main road, which point is 900 yards or thereabouts south-east of mile post 17 on the said road.
