No. 114.**THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW.**

CAP. 311 AND LAW 28 OF 1951.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12 (2).

Notice is hereby given that the immovable property, as hereinafter, is required by the Water Commission of Vouno in connection with a scheme for the supply and/or maintenance of a supply of water for the domestic purposes of the inhabitants of the said village under the provisions of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law.

Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the immovable property to which this notice relates, who objects to the acquisition of any such property, is required within six weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

The Water Commission of Vouno is willing to treat for the acquisition of the immovable property to which this notice relates.
