**No. 13.**                      **THE HOTELS LAW.**  
CAP. 104.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Hotels Law, Cap. 104, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Regulations, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Regulations, 1950, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Hotels Regulations, 1950 and 1952. *Gazette :

2. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraphs (a) and (b) thereof and the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:—

- "(a) a Camp Hotel 'A';
- (b) a Camp Hotel 'B'."

3. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "First Class camp hotel" (line 1 of that regulation and last line of paragraph (g) thereof) and the substitution therefor of the words "Camp Hotel 'A'."

4. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Second Class 'A' or 'B' camp hotel" (lines 1 and 2) and the substitution therefor of the words "Camp Hotel 'B'";
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the words "First Class camp hotels" (line 3) and the substitution therefor of the words "Camp Hotels 'A'".

5. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion in regulation 24 thereof of the following paragraph, the existing part of such regulation being lettered as paragraph (a):—

- "(b) Every hotel-keeper shall, at least once every month, supply to the Hotels Board or to any person authorized by the Hotels Board in that behalf a return showing the number of guests staying at his hotel."
