THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW.
 CAP. 311 AND LAW 28 OF 1951.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 12 (4).

Whereas immovable property is required by the Water Commissions of Prastio and Gaidhouras, Famagusta District, in connection with a joint scheme for the maintenance of a supply of water for the domestic purposes of the inhabitants of the said villages;

And whereas the Commissioner of Famagusta in compliance with section 12 (2) of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, by notice published under Notification No. 546 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 24th October, 1951, and posted at a conspicuous place in the villages concerned, gave a description and particulars of the immovable property required as aforesaid (hereinafter referred to as "the immovable property") and required any person claiming any right or interest therein to submit his claim with the necessary evidence in support thereof within the period therein set out;

And whereas the Commissioner of Famagusta at the expiration of the period set out in the aforesaid notice forwarded to the Governor a plan of the immovable property together with particulars as regards its owners, description and estimated value, no objections or statements having been received against the proposed acquisition;

And whereas I have approved the plan submitted and I consider it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the Water Commissions of Prastio and Gaidhouras should be permitted to acquire the immovable property:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 (4) of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the immovable property.

THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.
 CAP. 157.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 1st April and the 31st May, 1952, flocks within the village area of Theletra, in the District of Paphos, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.
