ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2534
MADE UNDER SECTION 79.

Whereas at a meeting of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta held on the 15th November, 1951, it was decided by the requisite majority of its members to sell the properties described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the properties") and registered in the name of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 79 of the Municipal Corporations Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby sanction the sale of the properties by the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta, by tender or public auction, with the reserve prices set out in the last column of the Schedule hereto and on condition that the proceeds of sale shall be placed in a separate Deposit Account and shall not be disposed of without my sanction.
