4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to the supply or acquisition of aviation spirit :---

(a) in pursuance of a licence granted by the Civil Aviation Officer authorizing the supply thereof;

- (b) by importation into the Colony; or
- (c) in the case of aviation spirit situate outside the Colony by delivery thereof outside the Colony.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.

6. This Order shall come into operation on the 12th day of May, 1952, and shall cease to have effect on the 9th day of June, 1952.
