THE BRITISH NATIONALITY (OFFENCES AND FEES)
LAW, 1949.

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 4.

J. FLETCHER-COOKE,
Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the British Nationality (Offences and Fees) Law, 1949, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Amendment Regulations, 1952, and shall be read as one with the British

Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1949 and 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1949 to 1952.

2. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—

CAP. 252 AND LAWS 11 OF 1950 AND 31 OF 1951.
