**THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950.**

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF TROODOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950, the Improvement Board of Troodos hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Troodos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Troodos Bye-laws, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Bye-laws”), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Troodos Bye-laws, 1951 and 1952.

2. Bye-law 23 of the principal Bye-laws, as set out in the First Appendix thereto, is hereby deleted and the following bye-law substituted therefor:—

“Bye-law 23. All carcasses shall be conveyed by the owner thereof from the slaughter-house to the meat market in containers which shall be properly covered to avoid contamination or in such other manner as may from time to time be prescribed by the Chairman.”

The above bye-laws have been approved by the Acting Colonial Secretary. (M.P. 1715/50.)
