CAP. 92.
Notice under Section 3 (1).
In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (I) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I do hereby absolutely prohibit-
(a) the removal of stones, shingie, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto ;
(b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto.

## Schedule.

Karavas Village.
Area A.
The foreshore commences at the mouth of the river Mavrolimni, locality "Lambousa", and thence proceeds eastwards along the coast to the mouth of the river Xyloyephyron, locality " Phtana", as shown edged yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1554, deposited at the office of the Commissioner, Kyrenia.

## Area B.

The foreshore commences at the most northern point of plot No. 215 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/9, locality "Vikla ", and thence proceeds eastwards along the coast to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 57/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/ro, locality " Ayios. Minas", as shown edged yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1554, deposited at the office of the Commissioner, Kyrenia.
The said foreshores include all the land within a distance of 50 yards from highwater mark throughout their lengths.
