that the restrictions imposed by the said Law shall not apply to the bakery at Amiandos of the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, so long as :---

- (a) persons employed in a nightshift shall not work for more than eight consecutive hours and shall have a break for meal each night;
- (b) a rotation system of one nightshift and two dayshifts shall be worked each extending over one week so as to ensure that no person shall be employed for more than six, or seven if a seven-day week is worked, consecutive nights in every three weeks.

This Order shall expire on the 31st day of December; 1952.

# THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW. CAP. 252 AND LAWS 11 OF 1950 AND 31 OF 1951.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LEFKONIKO.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefkoniko Cap. 252 hereby make the following bye-laws :--

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Suppl. No.3: Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) Bye-laws, 1940 to 1949 (hereinafter 15, 7,1940) referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these 11.12.1941 12.11.1942 bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkoniko) Bye-laws, 1940 to 1952.

2. Bye-law 84 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the 29. 9.1949 following bye-law substituted therefor :---

"84.-(1) Every owner or occupier of any building shall have a latrine.

(2) Wherever in these bye-laws there is a requirement for latrines, urinals, or wash-basins, the provisions of this chapter shall apply :

Provided that in the case of any premises other than premises used as a place of public resort the Council may dispense with, or modify, such of the requirements of this chapter as to the Council may seem fit, due regard being had to the size and value of such premises."
