THE CUSTOMS LAW.

CAP. 292 AND LAWS 2 OF 1950 AND 5 OF 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2554 MADE UNDER SECTION 52 (a).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 52 (a) of the Customs Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby 2 of 1950 order as follows:--

- r. This Order may be cited as the Customs (N.A.A.F.I.) Exemption Order, 1952.
- 2. In this Order the "N.A.A.F.I." means the Navy, Army and Air Force Institutes.
- 3. The exemption granted to the N.A.A.F.I. under Item 69 of the Second Schedule to the Customs Law, in respect of goods imported by the N.A.A.F.I. for sale to members of Her Majesty's Forces serving in the Colony, shall be extended as follows:-
  - (a) the scales of exemption under sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) thereof, instead of being calculated on the basis of monthly periods, shall be calculated on the basis of four-weekly periods; and
  - (b) the exemption granted in respect of whisky or gin, shall include both whisky and gin and shall be increased to two bottles of each for males, and one bottle of each for females.
- 4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 16th day of March, 1952.
