No. 485. THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAW. CAP. 203 AND LAWS 22 OF 1950 AND 17 OF 1952.

Whereas the Governor has, under section 73 of the Elementary Education Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), ordered the Town Cap. 203.
