THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW.  
CAP. 311 AND LAWS 28 OF 1951 AND 12 OF 1952.

(SECTION 12 (2)).

Notice is hereby given that the immovable property, as hereinafter, is required by the Water Commission of Palekhori (Orinis), in connection with a scheme for the supply and/or maintenance of a supply of water for the domestic purposes of the inhabitants of the said village under the provisions of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, Cap. 311.

Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the immovable property to which this notice relates, who objects to the acquisition of such property, is required within six weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

The Water Commission of Palekhori (Orinis) is willing to treat for the acquisition of the immovable property to which this notice relates.

The two-third share of the spring known as "Livadhia" spring, with its water and all private water rights appertaining thereto, on plot 1323 of sheet/plan 38/60 Palekhori (Orinis) and the earthen pond in plot 1358 of sheet/plan 38/60 Palekhori (Orinis) including all the water rights attached to plots 1357, 1359, 1360, 1355, 1356, 1341, 1345, 1344 and 1334 all of sheet/plan 38/60 Palekhori (Orinis).
