PERMIT UNDER SECTION 8.

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Law, the person whose name appears in the Schedule hereto has applied for a permit under the provisions of the said Law ;

And whereas the said person has given an undertaking in writing to pay all due obedience and respect to the Government of Cyprus, and while carefully abstaining from participation in political affairs, that he desires and purposes *ex animo* to work in friendly co-operation with the said Government in all matters in which his influence might properly be exerted ; and, in particular, he has undertaken that if engaged in educational work, his influence will be exerted to promote loyalty to the Government of Cyprus in the minds of his pupils and to make them good citizens of the British Empire :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby grant to the person whose name appears in the Schedule hereto a permit to commence or carry on the work set down after his name.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW.
CAP. 165 AND LAW 10 OF 1950.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

Cap. 165,
10 of 1950

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, as the appropriate authority under section 3 (2) (b) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby, with the approval of the Governor, define the areas described in the Schedules hereto as zones within which buildings of a lesser value than £3,000 shall not be erected.

SCHEDULE A.

All that area of land in the villages of Voroklini and Pyla in the district of Larnaca, lying between the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta and the sea and bounded on the north-east by plots Nos. 190, 193 and 92/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/19 (being part of the Dhekelia military Cantonment area) and on the south by plot No. 86 of Block C, Larnaca (on the municipal boundary of Larnaca), more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1546.

SCHEDULE B.

All that area of land in the villages of Livadhia, Voroklini and Pyla situated within 100 yards of the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta on its western and northern side and bounded on the north-east by plots Nos. 93 and 121/2 (part of) of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/10 (being part of the Dhekelia military Cantonment area) and on the south by plot No. 7 of Block C, Larnaca (on the municipal boundary of Larnaca), more particularly defined as the area coloured blue on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1546.
