THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW. CAP. 165 AND LAW 10 OF 1950.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

Cap. 165, 10 of 1950 In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, as the appropriate authority under section 3 (2) (b) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby, with the approval of the Governor, define the areas described in the Schedules hereto as zones within which buildings of a lesser value than $f_{3,000}$ shall not be erected.

Schedule A.

All that area of land in the villages of Voroklini and Pyla in the district of Larnaca, lying between the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta and the sea and bounded on the north-east by plots Nos. 190, 193 and 92/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/19 (being part of the Dhekelia military Cantonment area) and on the south by plot No. 86 of Block C, Larnaca (on the municipal boundary of Larnaca), more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1546.

SCHEDULE B.
