(b) to animals slaughtered in premises used as a Government Animal Quarantine Station:

Provided that no meat, carcass or edible offal of such animals shall be brought, sold or exposed for sale within the municipal limits unless such meat, carcass or edible offal—

- (i) bears visible and clear marks of the seal of such Quarantine Station and the appropriate stamp of the slaughter-house of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta and a fee of two piastres in respect of every oke of such meat, carcass or edible offal has been paid to the inspector; and
- (ii) be conveyed by the Famagusta Municipal Meat Motor Lorries on payment of such transport fees as may be fixed from time to time by the Council.
- (2) Save as is provided in paragraph (1) (a) of this bye-law, no person shall slaughter, skin, clean or dress, any animal outside the slaughter-house. The carcass of any animal slaughtered, skinned, cleaned or dressed outside the slaughter-house may be seized by any person in the service of the Council and disposed of as the Mayor may direct in writing."

The above bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor.

THE STREETS AND BUILDINGS REGULATION LAW. CAP. 165 AND LAW 10 OF 1950.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 14 (1) of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, the Municipal Corporation of Larnaca, as the appropriate authority of that Corporation under section 3 (2) (a) of the aforesaid Law, do hereby, with the approval of the Governor, define the area within the municipal limits of the said Corporation described in the Schedules A, B and C hereto as a zone within which buildings of a lesser value than three thousand pounds shall not be erected and the area described in Schedule D hereto as a zone within which buildings of a lesser value than one thousand five hundred pounds shall not be erected.

SCHEDULE A.

All that area of land within the municipal area of Larnaca, lying between the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta and the sea and bounded on the north-east by plot No. 193 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/33 (on the village boundary of Voroklini) and on the south by the Larnaca bye-pass road, more particularly defined as the area coloured green on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1547.

SCHEDULE B.

All that area of land within the municipal area of Larnaca situated within 100 yards of the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta on its western side and bounded on the north by plot No. 27 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/41 (on the village boundary of Livadhia) and on the south by the Larnaca bye-pass road, more particularly defined as the area coloured brown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1547.

SCHEDULE C.

All that area of land within the municipal area of Larnaca situated within 100 yards of each side of the Larnaca bye-pass road and bounded on the east by the Larnaca-Famagusta main road, and on the south by plots Nos. 592 and 593 of Block K, Larnaca, more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1547.

SCHEDULE D.

All that area of land within the municipal area of Larnaca situated within 100 yards of each side of the Larnaca bye-pass road and bounded on the north by plots Nos. 12, 595 (stud stables), 596, 19 and 8 of Block K, Larnaca, and on the south by the Larnaca-Nicosia main road, more particularly defined as the area coloured violet on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1547.
