### THE CUSTOMS LAW. CAP. 292.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2522 MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

A. B. WRIGHT, Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 52 of the Customs Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby Cap. 292 order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Motor Lorries (Importation) Prohibition Order, 1952.

2. The importation into the Colony of any motor lorry-

(a) the extreme width of which exceeds 7 feet;

(b) the extreme length of which exceeds 24 feet; or

(c) the turning circle of which exceeds 60 feet in diameter,

is prohibited save with a licence under the hand of the Colonial Secretary and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such licence.

3. The Import of Motor Lorries (Prohibition) Order, 1946, is hereby Gazette: revoked. Suppl. N
