- (3) New potatoes must be protected with wood wool, or other suitable packing material, at the top and the bottom of the baskets, to the satisfaction of the produce inspector.
- 2.—(1) Potatoes graded as "Selected", which are intended for export to the United Kingdom or the Far East, should be packed in the following manner:—
 - (a) In new hessian bags, the contents of which must not exceed 20 okes (56 lb.) net, or
 - (b) In wooden crates of any dimensions, approved by the produce inspector, or
 - (c) In paper-lined new baskets, the contents of which must not exceed 20 okes (56 lb.) net. The baskets must be of the same size and construction a those specified for "New Potatoes".
- (2)—(a) Potatoes graded as "Selected" which are intended for export to destinations other than the United Kingdom and the Far East, may be packed in the following manner:—
 - (i) In new hessian bags the contents of which must not exceed 40 okes (112 lb.) net, or
 - (ii) In wooden crates of any dimensions approved by the produce inspector, or
 - (iii) In paper-lined new baskets the contents of which must not exceed 40 okes (11 lb.) net.
- (b) The baskets must be of a standard shape and size and constructed in such a way so that four strenghtening wires projecting at the top are incorporated. The baskets should have the following dimensions:—

Internal height 21 inches.

Internal diameter at top 18 inches.

Internal diameter at bottom 12 inches.

IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF MORPHOU ("LACANIS" SUMMER WATER).

Rules.

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Association of Morphou ("Lacanis" Summer Water) Rules, 1953.
 - 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia;
 - "Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Association;
 - "Irrigation Association" means the Irrigation Association of Morphou ("Lacanis" Summer Water);
