NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to lay out and construct a new main road connecting the Kythrea Road and the Athena Boulevard north of the Altun (Caraffa) Bastion in the village of Palouriotissa and the town of Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the road"), and to acquire in connection therewith certain lands:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the laying out and construction of the road and the acquisition of the said lands to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Public Works.
