THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE EXPORT REGULATIONS, 1953.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 46 (b).

In pursuance to the provisions of regulation 46 (b) of the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953, it is hereby notified that the following pests or diseases from which potatoes intended for export should be free are scheduled :—

- Mealy bugs (*Pseudococcus citri* Risso).
- Potato Tuber Eelworm (*Ditylenchus destructor* Thorne).
- Late blight (*Phytophthora infestans* (Mont) de Bary).
- Common Scab (*Actinomyces spp.*).
- Dry Rot (*Fusarium spp.*).
- Blackleg (*Bacillus phytophthorus* Appel.).
- Spraing (An internal discolouration).
