DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 34 (1).

Whereas the Governing Body of the Commercial High School, Polemi (hereinafter referred to as "the School"), being a secondary school to which the provisions of section 34 of the Secondary Education Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") have been extended by Order in Council No. 2627 dated the 22nd day of June, 1953, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 25th June, 1953, subject to the conditions therein specified, has applied to the Governor for the declaration of the School to be a Public-aided Secondary School :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 34 (1) of the Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby declare the School to be a Public-aided Secondary School as from the 1st day of March, 1953.

No. 318. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law, I hereby give notice that except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby—

- (1) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto; and
