No. 331. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification published under No. 124 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th March, 1952, the Governor declared the carrying out of improvements to the Limassol Port, the provision of access roads thereto and the acquisition of certain lands mentioned in the aforesaid Notification, to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner, Limassol, by notice published under No. 549 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 10th December, 1952, gave particulars of the properties required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking;

And whereas the Commissioner forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plan and particulars, together with the objections made ;

And whereas, I, the Acting Governor, have approved the plan and particulars submitted, subject to slight amendments by the reduction of the area to be acquired from plots Nos. 10 and 39 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.II, Block IV, Djami Djedit Quarter and from Plot No. 364 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.II, Block V, Ayia Napa Quarter, Limassol, and from plot 212/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.I, Block III, Djami Djedit Quarter, Limassol, have considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the properties in question less the small areas of the said plots excluded by the amendment of the plan and particulars, be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition under the provisions of the said Law of the properties particulars whereof are specifically set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned immovable property situated in the town of Limassol, Ayia Napa and Djami Djedit Quarters, comprising $2\frac{3}{4}$ donums or thereabouts, including the whole of plots Nos. 368, 369, 370, 371, 373, 376 and part of plots Nos. 372, 374/1, 375, 365 and 364 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.II, Block V, Ayia Napa Quarters ; the whole of plots Nos. 42, 43, 44, 45, 38, part of plots Nos. 39 and 41, the whole of plots Nos. 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and part of plot No. 10 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.II, Block IV ; the whole of plots Nos. 220, 221, 222, 223, 225, 226, 231, 241, 242, 239, and part of plots Nos. 218, 219, 224, 227, 229, 230, 232, 233 and 240 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.II, Block III ; part of plots Nos. 212/2, 212/3, 213, 214, 216, 217 and the whole of plot No. 215 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.I, Block III, Djami Djedit Quarter, more particularly defined as the areas coloured red on the General Survey Plan Serial No. 1585.
