

2. Rule 20 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—

“Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep	—	6
(c) For every swine	2	0”

3. Rule 32 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—

“Rule 32. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) Per stall, per day	—	3
(b) Per stand, per day	—	2
(c) Per stall, per month	10	0”

4. Rule 46 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—

“Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) For every carcass of sheep or goat or part thereof	—	6
(b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof	—	4
(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof	1	0

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or a yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these rules.”

5. Rule 54 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—

“Rule 54.—(1) The following fee shall be paid by the owner of or the person exposing for sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say, for every carcass of swine or part thereof or portion of fresh pork, 2 shillings.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the inspector.”

**No. 370. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.
CAP. 142.**

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Pakhna, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

**RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF PAKHNA
UNDER SECTION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Pakhna hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Pakhna) (Amendment) Rules, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Pakhna) Rules, 1938 and 1946 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”) and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Pakhna) Rules, 1938 to 1953.

2. Rule 32 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following rule substituted therefor:—

“Rule 32. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) Perishable goods valued up to 5s.	-	3
(b) Perishable goods valued from 5s to 10s.	-	5
(c) Perishable goods valued from 10s. to £1.	1	0
(d) Perishable goods valued over £1	-	6 for each pound or part thereof :

Provided that grocers or Co-operative Stores Societies will be permitted to expose for sale in their premises potatoes only on payment of the fees fixed in rule 32 above for perishable goods exposed in the Perishable Goods Market, irrespective of whether such potatoes are transported by such persons or Stores from other villages or towns.”

3. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after rule 54 (2) of chapter 3, of the following new chapter:—

Chapter 4.—Market of Foodstuffs.

55. The Village Health Commission may from time to time appoint any premises or place within the area of the village to be the market of foodstuffs.

56. The management and control of the market of foodstuffs are hereby vested in the person appointed from time to time by the Village Health Commission to be the Inspector of the market of foodstuffs (hereinafter in this chapter of these Regulations referred to as “the Inspector”), subject to the instructions which he may from time to time receive from the Village Health Commission.

57. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any foodstuffs in the market of foodstuffs, that is to say:—

	<i>s.</i>	<i>p.</i>
(a) Foodstuffs valued up to 10s.	-	3
(b) Foodstuffs valued from 10s. to £1	-	5
(c) Foodstuffs valued over £1	-	4 for each pound or part thereof.

58. In this chapter of these rules the term ‘foodstuffs’ means any marketable commodities, articles, things or liquids used for human consumption but does not include any perishable goods or fresh meat or fresh pork.”

4. Part II of the Schedule to the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “Rules 1, 2, 21, 55, 56, 57, 58, 78 and 81” and the substitution therefor of the words “Rules 1, 2, 21, 78 and 81”.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF AYIOS SYMEON
(FAMAGUSTA DISTRICT) UNDER SECTION 9.
