THE PENSIONS LAW.

CAP. 288 AND LAW No. 4 OF 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2640 MADE UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

J. Fletcher-Cooke, Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 (1) of the Pensions Law, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:--

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) (Amendment Order), 1953, and shall be read together with the Gazette: Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Order, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. In addition to the offices declared to be pensionable offices under the principal Order the offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared pensionable offices for the purposes of the above Law.

THE COURTS OF JUSTICE (SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS) LAW.

CAP. 12.

Rules of Court made under Section 37.

Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Courts of Justice Cap. 12. (Supplementary Provisions) Law, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice and assistance of the Acting Chief Justice, do hereby make the following rules:---

1. These rules may be cited as the Rules of Court (No. 2), 1953, and shall be read as one with the Rules of Court, 1938 to 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Rules of Court, 1938 to (No. 2) 1953.

- 2. Rule 6 of Order 2 of the principal Rules is hereby amended as follows :-
 - (a) by the insertion of the word "and" immediately after the semicolon at the end of paragraph (3); and
 - (b) by the insertion therein after paragraph (3) of the following paragraph:
 - (4) In all other actions in the District Court (except actions for libel, slander, malicious prosecution, false imprisonment, seduction or breach of promise of marriage, and actions in which fraud is alleged by the plaintiff); "
