A CONTRACTOR OF THE SECOND

THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW.

CAP. 65.

Order under Section 4 (1) (l).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 4 (1)(1) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, Cap. 65, duly deputed to me under section 6 of the said Law by paragraph 3 of the Notification No. 527 published in the *Gazette* of the 3rd July, 1931, I, the Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby order as follows:—

- 1. All poultry in the Colony shall be inoculated with Newcastle Disease Vaccine.
- 2. The inoculations shall be carried out by Veterinary Officers or by such Vaccinators as may be appointed by me in writing in that behalf.
- 3. Every owner or person in charge of poultry shall produce such poultry for inoculation at such place and at such time as shall be appointed by a Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator as aforesaid by notice posted in a conspicuous place in the village concerned, and every such owner or person in charge shall render full assistance to the Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator in the inoculation of the poultry as aforesaid.
