

No. 480. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.
CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Gypsos, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF GYPSOS UNDER SECTION 9.

Cap. 142. In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Gypsos hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Gypsos) (Amendment) Rules, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Gypsos) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Gypsos) Rules, 1938 to 1953.

2. Rules 20 and 46 of the principal Rules are hereby repealed and the following rules substituted therefor, respectively:—

"Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say:—

(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox	-	4
(b) For every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	-	2
(c) For every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	-	1
(d) For every swine above 30 okes carcass weight	-	4
(e) For every swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight	-	2
(f) For every he-goat or ram over one year of age	-	2."

"Rule 46. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

(a) For every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox	2	0
(b) For every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	-	6
(c) For every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	-	6
(d) For every carcass of swine above 30 okes carcass weight	2	0
(e) For every carcass of swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight	1	0
(f) For every carcass of he-goat or ram over one year of age	-	6."

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF DHYMES IN THE DISTRICT OF LIMASSOL UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Dhymes hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Dhymes) Rules, 1953, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this rule, the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the "Model Rules"), published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th November, 1952, shall—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Dhymes and to be incorporated herein, and

(b) apply to the village of Dhymes:

Provided that for the word "Nikos" and for the word "Nicosia" wherever they occur in the Model Rules, the word "Dhymes" and the word "Limassol" shall be substituted respectively.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952.

(3) Those rules of the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Dhymes.

RULES TO BE SUBSTITUTED.

Rule 19. The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say :—

Rule 45. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(c) For every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof	2	0

Rule 56. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any food-stuffs in the market of foodstuffs, that is to say :—

(b) Per stand, per day	—	6
(c) Per stall, per month	15	0

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF AGRIDHIA IN THE DISTRICT OF LIMASSOL UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Agridhia hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Agridhia) Rules, 1953, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this rule, the Village Health (Nikos) Rules, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the "Model Rules"), published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th November, 1952, shall—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Agridhia and to be incorporated herein, and

(b) apply to the village of Agridhia:

Provided that for the word "Nikos" and for the word "Nicosia" wherever they occur in the Model Rules, the word "Agridhia" and the word "Limassol" shall be substituted respectively.
