Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Agridhia in the District of Limassol UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Agridhia hereby make the following rules:-

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Agridhia) Rules, 1953, and shall come into operation on their publication in the Gazette.

THE IRRIGATION (PRIVATE WATER) ASSOCIATION LAW, 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Association of Potamia ("Portalomo" Water), in the District of Nicosia, are published in the Gazette.

IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF POTAMIA ("PORTALOMO" WATER).

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Association of Potamia ("Portalomo" Water) Rules, 1953.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires-

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia;

"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Association;
"Irrigation Association" means the Irrigation Association of Potamia ("Portalomo"

"Law" means the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949;

"List" means the list of the names and residences of the proprietors and of the extent of the interest of each proprietor in the water, as finally settled in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of the Law; "Water" means the water commonly known as "Portalomo" Water;

"Works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Association.

3. The present Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 19th July, 1953. The election of each subsequent Committee shall take place in the manner hereinafter provided every third year in the first week of the month of July, and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of the expiration of the period of office of the previous Committee.
