PRESCRIPTION OF SENIOR POSTS AND DUTY ALLOWANCES UNDER SECTION 34.

Cap. 203. 22 of 1950 17 of 1952 28 of 1953. In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 34 of the Elementary Education Laws, I, the Governor, do hereby order and prescribe as follows:—

- 1. The posts shewn in the second column of the Schedule hereto shall be senior posts carrying the duty allowances shewn in the third column, respectively.
- 2. This prescription shall be deemed to have been made and to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1953.
- 3. Paragraph I and the Schedule of the Prescription of Senior Posts, Duty Allowances, Additional Qualifications and Special Allowances under sections 34 and 35 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944, are hereby superseded provided that the present Assistant Headmasters and Assistant Headmistresses will continue to be paid an allowance at the old rates for so long as they occupy these posts. Such allowances will be discontinued when they move from their present posts.

1	Headteachers in 6 and over teacher schools	£60 per annum.
2	Headteachers in 4 or 5 teacher schools	£40 per annum.
3	Headteachers in 3 teacher schools	£20 per annum.
