Authority to the Famagusta Water Board to contract a loan.

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor has consented to the borrowing by the Water Board of Famagusta from the Loan Commissioners of the sum of three hundred and thirty thousand pounds ($f_{330,000}$) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Loan Commissioners in thirty equal annual instalments (comprising capital and interest);
- (b) the sum borrowed shall be withdrawn in instalments in multiples of $f_{,1,000}$ and shall be utilized by the Board for general purposes connected with the Famagusta Water Supply Scheme including the purchase of pipes and equipment required by it.
