CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to acquire certain lands situated at Polis, in the District of Paphos, for the purpose of erecting thereon a Moslem Secondary School (Orta Okul):

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the acquisition of the said lands for the aforesaid purpose to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the Governing Body for the Moslem Secondary School, Polis, with the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking, the cost whereof shall be borne by the Governing Body herebefore mentioned.

(The Governing Bodies for the Moslem Secondary Schools have been recognized as public bodies for the purposes of the Land Acquisition Law, under Notification No. 23 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 21st January, 1953.)
