THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE EXPORT REGULATIONS, 1953.

Notice under Regulation 14 (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by regulation 14 (b) of the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953, I, the Director of Agriculture, do hereby direct that, until further notice, rubbed sage leaves intended for export to any country shall be packed in new clean hessian bags, provided that :

- (a) the bags are marked with the words "Rubbed Sage" in letters not less than two inches in size,
- (b) the rubbed sage leaves conform to the provisions of the regulation 53 of the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953; the degree of finess shall be to the satisfaction of the Produce Inspector.
