

3. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (1) thereof:—

“(1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3) of this Regulation it shall not be lawful for any person to work as port worker in any port where these Regulations apply unless he is registered in accordance with paragraph (1) of Regulation 4 of these Regulations and is allocated to an employer by the manager.”.

4. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the following paragraphs for paragraph (3) thereof:—

“(3) If the wages are not fixed and the working conditions are not determined as provided in paragraph (2) of this Regulation the Chairman of the Board shall refer the question for determination to a tribunal consisting of a Chairman and two members appointed by the Governor, one member representing employers' interests and the other member workers' interests. Any decision of such tribunal shall be final and binding on all parties.

(4) For the purposes of this Regulation “employer” means any employer of workers.”.

THE ANTIQUITIES LAW.

CAP. 43.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 11.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Cap. 43. In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11 of the Antiquities Law, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

From and after the date of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette* no building shall be erected, reconstructed or repaired and no tree shall be felled within the areas adjacent to an ancient monument to wit the site and remains of the Temple of Venus in the village of Koukليا (Palea Paphos), comprising the plots specified in the Schedule hereto save in accordance with the terms of a permit in writing from the Commissioner previously obtained.

SCHEDULE.

All those areas of land situated in the village of Koukليا (Palea Paphos), comprising ten donums or thereabouts and including plots Nos. 167, 168, 170, 171, 172, 173, 174, 224, 225/1, 225/2, 225/3, 226/1, 226/2, 227/1, 227/2, 227/3, 228/1, 228/2, 229, 230, 231, 233, 235, 238, 239, 240/1, 240/2, 240/3, 241, 242, 249, 250, 252, 253, 272, 273, 274, 275/1, 275/2, 276, 277, 278 and 281 of the Government Survey Plan of Koukليا (Palea Paphos), more particularly defined as the areas bordered in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1578, deposited in the office of the Director of Land Registration and Surveys, at Nicosia.
