REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Post Office Law, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) Regulations, 1942 to 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) Regulations, 1942 to (No. 2) 1953.

2. Sub-regulation (2) of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures " £20 " for the figures " £50 ", which occur in the last line thereof.

3. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures " £20 " for the figures " £120 ", which occur in the last line thereof.

4. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the figures " £20 " for the figures " £120 ", which occur in the last line thereof.

5. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1954.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE No. 307 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion of Part 3A and the substitution thereof of the following Part with effect from the 2nd January, 1954 :—

" PART 3A.—LOCAL WHEATEN FLOUR.
