## GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

## A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

I, the Governor, do hereby grant unto the person whose name appears in the first column of the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "grantee" which expression shall include his heirs and permitted assigns), the land described in the second column of the Schedule, subject to the following conditions to be observed by him, that is to say:—

(a) the grantee shall pay to the Government of Cyprus the amount appearing in

the third column of the Schedule;

(b) the land shall not be registered in the name of the grantee and the grantee shall not charge, sell or in any other way directly dispose of the land or any part thereof;

(c) the grantee shall not erect or cause to be erected any structure whatsoever on the

land.

And this grant is subject to this further condition, that is to say:—

Upon the breach or non-observance of any of the conditions hereinbefore stated, this grant shall be revoked and cancelled and in such case—

(a) the grantee shall forthwith vacate the land; and

(b) any structure erected on the land in contravention of condition (c), as hereinbefore, shall vest in, and become the property of, the Crown without payment to the grantee of any compensation whatsoever.
