

No. 79. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.
CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas immovable property is required by Her Majesty's Military Authorities in connection with the establishment of a military cantonment within the villages of Paramali, Sotira, Episkopi and Evdhimou in the District of Limassol ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Limassol, in compliance with section 6 of the Land Acquisition Law, by Notice published under Notification No. 47, in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 4th February, 1953, and posted at convenient places on or near the lands to be acquired, gave a description and particulars of the immovable property required as aforesaid (hereinafter referred to as the "immovable property") and required any person claiming any right or interest thereon to submit his claim with the necessary evidence in support thereof within the period therein set out ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Limassol at the expiration of the period set out in the aforesaid Notice forwarded to the Governor a plan of the immovable property together with particulars as regards its owner and description and an objection by the owner ;

And whereas, having considered the objection made thereto, I have approved the plan submitted and I consider it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that Her Majesty's Military Authorities should be permitted to acquire the immovable property :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the immovable property.

No. 80. THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE
SUPPLIES LAW.
