## THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to the Notification published under No. 30 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 28th January, 1953, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All those areas of privately-owned immovable property situated in the villages of Evdhimou and Paramali, in the District of Limassol, comprising 57½ donums or thereabouts including part of plots Nos. 96, 100, 101, 102, 103, 105, 131, 125, 130, 126, 127 and 128 of the Government Survey Plan No. LII.64, part of plots Nos. 163, 164, 165, 166, 169, 170, 172, 134, 173, 125, 122, 121, 120, 119, 60, 61, 62, 55, 68, 69, 53 and the whole of plots Nos. 304 and 340 of the Government Survey Plan No. LVII 8, more particularly defined as the areas coloured red on the Government Survey Plan signed by me and dated 26th January, 1954.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within ten days from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office.

5. Notification No. 75 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 4th February, 1954, is hereby cancelled, without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

## OVERTIME WORK AND FEES.

Cap. 292

In exercise of the powers vested in the Comptroller by section 6 (4) of the Customs Law, I hereby prescribe that from and after the 1st March, 1954, overtime at the rates prescribed in the Schedule hereto shall be charged for the services of Customs Officers where permitted to carry out overtime outside the hours and days prescribed in clauses 2 and 3 of the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Order, 1953.

2. Overtime charges shall be calculated in full for each vessel or operation requiring the attendance of Customs Officers without reference to the number of vessels or operations being worked in any period.

3. Notification No. 646, published in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 3732 of the 17th December, 1953, is hereby cancelled as from the 1st March, 1954.

The above charges shall be increased by 50 per centum when overtime work is required to be performed before 8.00 a.m. or after 4.00 p.m. on any Sunday or other day appointed by the Governor to be a day when Customs Houses are closed for business:

Provided that ships whose overtime work falls under more than one category shall for such period they are actually so working, pay the higher rate plus 50% of the lower category or, if two rates are similar, one rate plus 50% of the other. No ship shall be charged under more than one rate and 50% of another:

Provided also that where overtime work applied for is performed, the minimum charge shall be as for  $\frac{1}{2}$  an hour, except on Sundays and public holidays, where charge as for 1 hour shall be the minimum.

If cancellation of an application for overtime is, in the opinion of the Collector, made in sufficient time before the attendance has been applied for to allow of staff being advised and attendance avoided, such cancellation shall be made without charge.

If overtime has been applied for and the aircraft or vessel does not arrive and the application for overtime attendance has not been cancelled in sufficient time to prevent attendance of the officers detailed, charge will be made as for a minimum of one hour and, if not cancelled upon the expiration of one hour from the hour of commencement of overtime work as applied for, until cancellation is made. The charge made shall be for the total number of hours of attendance up to the time of cancellation subject to any part not exceeding half an hour following the first hour being charged for as for half an hour.

**No. 148. THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW.**

CAP. 65.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 4 (1) (I).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 4 (1) (I) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, Cap. 65, duly deputed to me under section 6 of the said Law by paragraph 3 of the Notification No. 527 published in the *Gazette* of the 3rd July, 1931, I, the Chief Veterinary Officer, hereby order as follows:—

1. All sheep and goats in the Colony, with the exception of sheep and goats, within the village areas of the villages set out in the Schedule hereto, shall be inoculated with anthrax vaccine.
2. The inoculations shall be carried out by Veterinary Officers or by such Vaccinators as may be appointed by me in writing in that behalf.
3. Every owner or person in charge of sheep or goats shall produce such sheep or goats for inoculation at such place and at such time as shall be appointed by a Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator as aforesaid by notice posted in a conspicuous place in the village concerned, and every such owner or person in charge shall render full assistance to the Veterinary Officer or Vaccinator in the inoculation of the sheep or goats as aforesaid.
