## THE GRAIN CONTROL LAW, 1953. Law 7 of 1953.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2683.

CONTROL ORDER UNDER SECTIONS 3 (1) AND 18.

Whereas it appeared to the Governor-in-Council to be necessary or expedient for the purpose of securing a sufficiency of wheat and barley, kinds of grain essential to the well-being of the community, and for the purpose of their equitable distribution and availability at fair prices that the aforesaid kinds of grain be controlled in the public interest:

And whereas it appeared further to the Governor-in-Council that the public interest requires that bread should be included in such Order:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 3 (1) and 18 of the Grain Control Law, 1953, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Wheat, Barley and Bread (Control) Order, 1954.
- 2. Wheat and barley are hereby declared to be controlled articles under the provisions of the aforementioned Law and it is further declared that bread is included as a controlled article for all the purposes of the aforesaid Law.
- 3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation and to have taken effect from the 1st May, 1954.

THE GRAIN CONTROL LAW, 1953.
