No. 310. THE PUBLIC RIVERS PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 143.

NOTIFICATION.

1. Whereas the portion of the Public River Pedias, in the village of Trakhonas, in the District of Nicosia, commencing at the bridge of the Nicosia-Kyrenia main road near the 2nd milepost and proceeding north-eastwards for a distance of 2,250 feet or thereabouts, and ending at a line which is a straight continuation of the eastern boundary of plot No. 464 of "Block B" of Trakhonas village to the left bank of the said river, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan No. 1593, filed in M.P. (D.I.N.) 7/49 in the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia, has been declared by the Pedias River (Protection) Order, 1954, to be a river for the purposes of the Public Rivers Protection Law;
