No. 337. THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW.

CAP. 39.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce Export (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce Export Regulations, 1953 and 1954. *Gazette:*

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second Appendix thereto and the substitution therefor of the following Appendix :—

INSPECTION FEES.

(a) Citrus Fruit :	
For each case or basket of citrus fruit submitted for inspection	1
For each 1,000 fruit shipped in bulk	4
(b) Pomegranates :	
For each package of pomegranates submitted for inspection ..	$0\frac{1}{2}$
For every 50 okes or part thereof of pomegranates shipped in bulk	$0\frac{1}{2}$
(c) Fresh Fruit :	
For each package of fresh fruit submitted for inspection ..	$0\frac{1}{2}$
For every 50 okes or part thereof of fresh fruit shipped in bulk ..	$0\frac{1}{2}$
(d) Dried Fruit :	
For each package of dried fruit submitted for inspection ..	1

	<i>Piastres.</i>
(e) Nuts :	
For each package of unshelled nuts submitted for inspection	0½
For each package of shelled nuts submitted for inspection ..	2
(f) Onions :	
For each package of onions submitted for inspection ..	0½
(g) Potatoes :	
For each package of certified seed potatoes submitted for inspection	1½
For each package of potatoes other than certified seed submitted for inspection	0½
(h) Sage Leaves :	
For each 100 okes or part thereof of sage leaves submitted for inspection	2
(i) Tobacco :	
For each bale of yellow-leaf tobacco submitted for inspection	3
(j) For any produce exported for manufacturing purposes the packages of which are so marked the inspection fees payable shall be one-half of the above fees.	
(k) For produce presented for re-inspection, the inspection fees payable shall be double the above fees."

No. 338. THE PUBLIC RIVERS PROTECTION LAW.
CAP. 143.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2688

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

Cap. 143.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Public Rivers Protection Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Yialias River (Protection) Order, 1954.
2. The portion of the public river Yialias, in the villages of Mathiati, Kochati, Ayia Varvara and Perakhorio, in the District of Nicosia, commencing from a straight line between the south-eastern corner of plot No. 237 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXIX.13 (and crossing the said river) and the most northern point of plot No. 413 of the said plan, and proceeding downstream for a distance of 2 miles and 1,000 yards or thereabouts to the straight line between the most southern point of plot No. 222 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXIX.6 (and crossing the said river) and the most northern point of plot No. 219 of the said plan, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan, Serial No. 1611, filed in M.P. (D.I.N.) 64/51 in the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia, is hereby declared to be a river for the purposes of the Public Rivers Protection Law.

3. This Order shall be in addition to the Yialias River (Protection) Order, 1952.
