BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF
PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to (No. 4) 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1954.

2. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 178 of the following new bye-law :—

" 178A.—(1) Except with the written consent of the Council, previously obtained, no person shall within the municipal limits of Paphos—

- (a) cook or engage in cooking, or cause or permit cooking in any street ;
- (b) cook or engage in cooking or cause or permit to be cooked any food in any place of public resort within a distance of 100 feet from any street except under a licence of the Council subject to such terms and conditions as the Council may deem fit to impose :

Provided that nothing in this paragraph of this bye-law shall apply to the cooking of any food in any enclosed kitchen in any such place which complies with the provisions of these bye-laws.

(2) Nothing in this bye-law contained shall affect any right of any person against any other person for nuisance, annoyance or inconvenience which may be caused by the cooking of any food in any place whatsoever."

3. Sub-paragraph (a) (i) of paragraph (5) of bye-law 214 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following sub-paragraph substituted therefor :—

"(i) to any sports competition the takings of which are devoted either wholly or in part to philanthropic, charitable or educational purposes, or"

4. Sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) of bye-law 266 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951) are hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph substituted therefor :—

"266.—(1) Every licensee of an hotel of the 1st class shall pay to the town treasurer a fee of 4 piastres per night, and every licensee of an hotel of any other class shall pay a fee of 3 piastres per night, in respect of every person of over 10 years of age staying or residing at such hotel.

(2) The total amount of fees collected under this bye-law shall be paid to the town treasurer at the office of the Municipal Corporation at least once a week".

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LEFKARA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law and otherwise, the council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefkara hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkara) Amendment Bye-laws, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Lefkara) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lefkara) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1954.

2. Paragraph (1) of bye-law 133F of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th March, 1947) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures "12s. 4½p." and "20s." and the substitution therefor of the figures "15s." and "23s." respectively.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th November, 1947), is hereby amended by the deletion of the figure and words "1½ piastres per kantar" opposite item 7 thereof and the substitution therefor of the figure and words "3 piastres per kantar".
