THE POLICE LAW.

CAP. 265 AND LAW 24 OF 1953

Cap. 265

24 of 1953

Rules Made under Section 52B.

In exercise of the powers visted in him by section 52B of the Police Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Cyprus Police Association (Amendment) Rules, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Police Association Rules, 1953 (as set out in the Schedule to Law 24 of 1953, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Police Accociation Rules, 1953 and 1954.
- 2. Rule 3 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following proviso (the full stop at the end thereof being replaced by a colon):—

"Provided that for the purpose of these Rules a Constable appointed by the Commissioner to be in charge of a police station shall not be deemed to be a non-commissioned officer".

- 3. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after Rule 4 of the following new Rule:—
 - "4A. Any police officer attached to my Police Division, who at the time of the election is at the Police Training School or temporarily on transfer away from his Division should vote for his Divisional candidate and not for the candidate of the Division to which he is temporarily attached".
