THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT)

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 22 (a) (i).

Authority to the Improvement Board of Strovolos to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 (a)(i) of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, I, the Colonial Secretary, do hereby order as follows :—

1. The Improvement Board of Strovolos (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lenders") a sum not exceeding five thousand two hundred pounds (£5,200) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Lenders in fifteen equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the purchase of a site on which a public market will be erected.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Board shall, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, mortgage to the Lenders all the rates, fees, rents, tolls or charges now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Board.

THE POST OFFICE LAW.
CAP. 281 AND LAW 44 OF 1953.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 of the Post Office Law, His Excellency the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) Regulations, 1942 to (No. 2) 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Post Office (Insurance of Letters, Boxes and Parcels) Regulations, 1942 to 1954.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein in their alphabetical order of the words "Kakopetria" and "Lapithos".

3. These regulations shall come into operation on the 28th day of July, 1954.
