No. 497. ✓ THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.  
CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

R. P. ARMITAGE,

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to layout, construct and protect new main roads in and to the west of the town of Nicosia and to acquire for these purposes certain lands in the town of Nicosia and in the villages of Ayios Dhometios, Orta Keuy and Engomi :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the provisions of the said main roads and the protection thereof to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Director of Public Works.
