Notification under Section 65.

It is hereby notified that, by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 65 of the Customs Law and duly deputed to the Colonial Cap. 292 Secretary, I hereby approve the premises described in the first column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to Messrs. THE ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT LAWS, 1952 TO 1954.
