## No. 547. V THE VILLAGE AUTHORITIES LAW. CAP. 256 AND LAW 17 OF 1951.

#### PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 17.

### R. P. Armitage,

Governor.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Mamonia and Phasoula in the District of Paphos :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Law and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby proclaim that from and after the 15th September, 1954, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Mamonia in the District of Paphos, shall form part of the lands of the village of Phasoula, in the District of Paphos, and that the boundaries of the said villages of Mamonia and Phasoula shall be altered accordingly.

#### SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Mamonia village to Phasoula village :---

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 12 of the Government Survey Plan No. LII. 18, locality " Pontikokhoraphon " which corner is at corner of the bridge carrying the Nikoklia-Mamonia road over the stream "Argakin tou Pikrou" and proceeds north-eastwards along the said road to the most southern point of plot No. 6 of the said plan, locality "Hilas"; thence north-eastwards and south-eastwards along the boundaries of and including the last mentioned plot and plot No. 2 of the said plan, plots Nos. 17, 28, 27, 97, 24 and 101 of the Government Survey Plan No. LII.10 to the north-eastern corner of the last mentioned plot, which corner is on the right bank of the river Dhiarrizos ; thence south-eastwards in a straight line (across the said river) to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 15 of the Government Survey Plan No. LII.18, locality "Kalamos"; thence south-westwards along the eastern boundary of the said plot to the most northern point of plot No. 93of the said plan, which point is on the boundary between the villages of Mamonia and Phasoula ; thence south-westwards along the said boundary to its junction with the boundary between the villages of Mamonia and Souskiou ; thence south-westwards, westwards and north-eastwards along the said boundary to the point of commencement, the boundary of all which said area is shown edged in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1620.
